Critical Care Outreach Team (CCOT): Specialized critical care support is just a phone call away.

Call when any patient displays an early warning sign of clinical deterioration.

EARLY WARNING SIGNS:



- ❑ Threatened airway
- ❑ Oxygen saturation < 90% and/or increasing O2 needs
- ❑ Respiratory rate <10 or >30 breaths/minute



- ❑ Systolic blood pressure <90 or >210 mmHg
- ❑ Heart rate <40 or >140 beats/minute



- ❑ Sudden change/decrease in LOC



- ❑ Urine output <100ml over past 4 hours



- ❑ Elevated MEWS score



- ❑ Clinician/caregiver concern.
If you are worried, that is reason enough.

The CCOT is a dedicated, 24/7 service that aims to respond to all calls within 5 minutes.
